

# GISH Grading System

Grand Island Senior High grades are recorded on the following scale. Progress reports are issued each six weeks. Only the semester grade is placed on the transcript.

<b>A</b>	<b>90-100</b>	<b>Excellent</b>
<b>B</b>	<b>80-90</b>	<b>Good</b>
<b>C</b>	<b>70-80</b>	<b>Satisfactory</b>
<b>D</b>	<b>60-70</b>	<b>Needs Improvement</b>
<b>F</b>	<b>Below 60</b>	<b>No Credit</b>

## Class Rank

Class rank will be determined using a class ranking point system. Students will receive class rank points for each enrolled course based on the grade received in the course. Pass/Fail course are not included in the GPA. B-level courses receive one less point than regular courses. AP courses receive one more point than regular courses.

In order to rank number one in their class, students must have all A's and enroll in two semesters of AP during their sophomore year, two semesters of AP during their junior year and 4 semesters of AP during their senior year.

## To Rank Number One

Grade 9 - All A's

Grade 10 - All A's in 120 credits and two semesters of AP

Grade 11 - All A's in 180 credits and two semesters of AP

Grade 12 - All A's in 240 credits and four semesters of AP

(total AP required - 8 semesters)

## Academic Letter

**Freshmen** must have a first semester GPA of 4.00.

**Sophomores** must have a three semester GPA of 3.75.

**Juniors** must have a five semester GPA of 3.50.

**Seniors** must have a seven semester GPA of 3.25.

**Honor Roll:** To be on the Honor Roll, a student must be enrolled in 25 credits and have a GPA of 3.0 the previous semester.
