

GERMAN 3-4

Course Length: Two semesters

Grade Levels: 10,11,12

Prerequisite Courses: German 1-2

Course Description:

This course continues the acquisition of German language skills and cultural awareness. Complexity of communication improves as vocabulary, grammar and sentence structure are presented in more depth. Reading, writing, listening, and speaking are further developed with emphasis on cooperative groups and role-playing.

German 3-4 Course Standards

As a result of their participation in this course, students will:

- Communicate orally with others in more detail, using present, past, and future tense verbs.
- Understand more complex spoken German and respond properly.
- Develop an awareness of native speakers' use of German.
- Analyze German texts for reading comprehension.
- Write compositions using the six-trait writing model.
- Note differences and similarities between American and German-speaking cultures.
- Develop projects using German vocabulary with written and oral descriptions.
