

SPANISH 3-4

Course Length: Two Semesters

Grade Levels: 9,10,11,12

Prerequisite Courses: Spanish 1-2

Course Description:

This course focuses primarily on Spanish vocabulary and grammar, including verb tenses and pronouns. All essential aspects of Spanish will be addressed through oral and written work. Reading and writing in Spanish will be emphasized more during the second semester.

Spanish 3-4 Course Standards

As a result of their participation in this course, students will:

- Identify and understand assorted grammatical aspects and their function.
- Use a wide variety of grammatical constructions to improve sentence fluency.
- Comprehend written and oral information.
- Analyze various Spanish text to improve communication skills.
- Use higher level thinking and the six-trait writing model to write about one's own ideas.
- Write compositions using the six-trait writing model.
- Gain basic communicate skills in the forms of reading, writing, speaking, and listening.
