

SPANISH 5-6

Course Length: Two Semesters

Grade Level: 11, 12

Prerequisite Courses: Spanish 3-4

Course Description:

This course focuses primarily on the vocabulary and fluency of the Spanish language, with emphasis on the oral and written components as well as essential grammatical and verb tenses. The writing component will be emphasized through weekly journals.

Spanish 5-6 Course Standards

As a result of their participation in this course, students will:

- Communicate in the Spanish language as much as possible with fluency.
- Apply all their current grammatical knowledge to the writing, and speaking.
- Write about different topics using the six-trait writing model.
- Use the language in a variety of real life experiences.
- Read authentic materials including newspapers, magazines, advertisements, product packaging, signs, maps (realia) with ease.
- Understand the Spanish culture and the people via different means.
- Develop understanding of the culture through the study of the language.
