

SPANISH FOR NATIVE SPEAKERS

Course Length: Two semesters

Grade Levels: 10,11,12

Prerequisite Courses: Literacy in Spanish

Course Description:

This course addresses the grammatical and written skills of native speakers, with some history, civilization, and literature included. A testing out option is available for Spanish 1-2 and 3-4.

Spanish for Native Speakers Course Standards

As a result of their participation in this course, students will:

- Analyze and comprehend the grammatical aspects of Spanish which produce orthographic changes (spelling related to sounds).
- Use appropriate grammar when dealing with problematic situations in Spanish.
- Construct multiple compositions in Spanish which follow the six-trait writing model.
- Perform, in Spanish, oral presentations to demonstrate mastery of language and oratorical techniques.
- Characterize assorted literary works concerning both ideas and structures.
- Analyze various historical and cultural aspects of the diverse Spanish speaking world.
