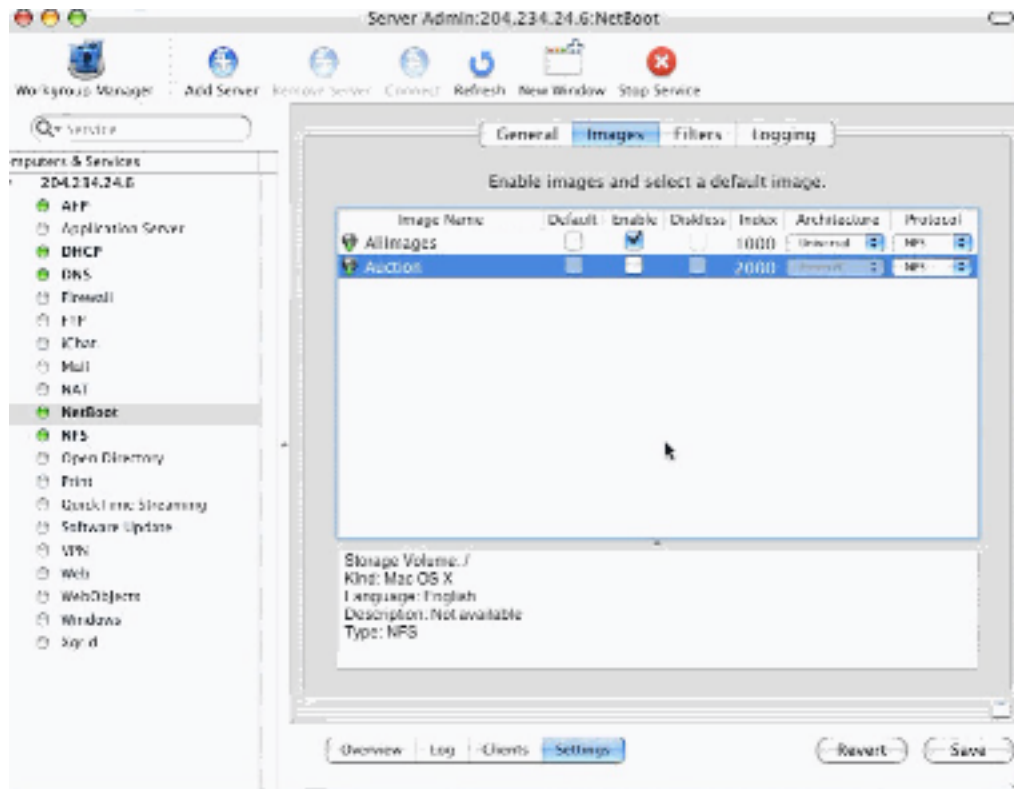


NETBOOT 2008

Your DNS server has two different netboot images. When you start a computer holding down the "N" key, the workstation will attempt to boot to whatever is enabled below. Only one of these options can be enabled at a time. Most everything will boot to AllImages, however, if you see a blue screen or a screen of death, you will need to enable Auction and the netboot again.

- 1) AllImages - causes computers to netboot to 10.5 (Leopard)
- 2) Auction - causes computers to netboot to 10.4 (Tiger)

With ARD control your DNS server (204.234.xx.6) and open Server Admin. Highlight the NetBoot option.



Here is a list of the image options when netbooting:

Auction (only on Auction option)

Bldg_eMac (on both options)
Goes on all eMacs and snow iMacs

Bldg_iBookG4 (on both options)
All iBooks

Bldg_iMacIntel (only on AllImages)
All flat panel iMacs and the new Silver iMacs

Bldg_MacBook (only on AllImages)
All MacBooks except administrators (we will do all administrators)

When you see the black screen of death (says to reboot your computer), you will need to switch to the Auction option, then netboot. Select an eMac image, iBookG4 image or Auction image, depending on what you are netbooting. Most all of the auction iMacs and iBooks have already been done.
