Dear Parent / Guardian,

Welcome to the School District of Grand Island. It is our pleasure to work with your family. As a condition of enrollment it is the policy of the school district to require a medical examination upon a child's entrance into kindergarten and seventh grade, and when a child transfers to this school district from another state. Nebraska Law also requires this medical examination, as well as immunizations.

The required immunizations may be obtained from your family physician, or from the Central District Health Department. Immunizations are given twice a week at the Health Department located at 1137 South Locust Street (385-5175). A \$13 administration fee is requested per visit, however, no child is turned away for inability to pay. Please call ahead for an appointment. (The Health Department does not perform the Kindergarten physical examination ... they only offer the immunizations.)

Please take the medical evaluation form with you when obtaining the physical from your physician so he or she can complete and record the findings after examining your child. It is necessary for you to make available a record of your child's immunizations if the records do not already include these.

This medical evaluation is an important part of your child's preparation for entering school and we urge you to arrange to have it done as soon as possible. Please return the form to school after completion. The school district staff looks forward to serving your child.
