Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

Terms of Payment

The scholarships will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university. Payments will be made in equal installments for two semesters. The student must provide proof of enrollment to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation and maintain at least a 2.5 G.P.A.
