This scholarship is a celebration of their 50 years of business in the Grand Island community and their commitment to young people who have helped their business grow. This scholarship is a \$2,500 one year award. The scholarship is intended for students who are hard-working and need the additional support to realize their college ambitions.

Eligibility

- Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior High
- Must major in business, accounting, marketing, or finance
- Must have a GPA between 3.2 and 3.7

Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

Terms of Payment

The scholarship will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university. Payments of up to \$2,500 (\$1,250 per semester) will be made. The student must provide proof of enrollment to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.
