

Central Nebraska Home Builders Association – Jim Roth Memorial Scholarship

The Central Nebraska Home Builders Association has established this scholarship in memory of Grand Island Home Builder Jim Roth. Roth built homes in and around Grand Island for several years, including many homes in the Brentwood area. Roth was active in the Home Builders Association and did much to promote the construction trades and Central Nebraska Home Builders. He lost his life prematurely in a plane crash. As a thank you to Roth, the Central Nebraska Home Builders have created this scholarship as his legacy. The scholarship is a one-year award in the amount of \$500 or more.

Eligibility

- Must be a graduate of a Hall County High School School (Grand Island Senior High, Central Catholic High, Doniphan-Trumbull High, Grand Island Northwest High, Heartland Lutheran High, Wood River High)
- Must be pursuing a degree, certificate, or diploma in a home-building trade, such as construction management, plumbing, heating and air, electrician etc.
- Must meet requirements of acceptance to the trade program at an accredited post-secondary school of choice

Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

Terms of Payment

The scholarships will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university. Payments will be made in equal installments for two semesters. The student must provide proof of enrollment to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.
