

Charles R. & Bessie E. Frith Scholarship

Charles and Bessie Frith have created this annual scholarship for deserving young men and women who are graduates of Grand Island Senior High School. The scholarship is a \$3,000 two- year award. The scholarship is intended for students who are hardworking and need the additional support to realize their college ambitions.

Eligibility

- Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior High
- Must demonstrate financial need by qualifying for the free or reduced school lunch program
- Must have the ability to succeed in college, however, an honor-roll grade point average is not necessary. A 2.0 or 3.0 grade point average is acceptable
- Must demonstrate ability to work hard for desired goals
- Must demonstrate good character and citizenship
- Must attend a public Nebraska trade school or University. Examples: Central Community College, Southeast Community College, University of Nebraska, Peru State College, Wayne State College, etc.

Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

Terms of Payment

The scholarship will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to a Nebraska accredited 2 or 4 year college or university. Payments of up to \$3,000 (\$750 per semester) will be made. The student must provide proof of enrollment to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.
