

Gene Haas Foundation Scholarship

To spur the development of the next-generation of advanced manufacturing professionals, the Gene Haas Foundation awards high school seniors seeking a post-secondary degree in machining and advanced manufacturing technology. Up to \$10,000 is available. Scholarships may be awarded in any number or amount determined by the recommendation of the selection committee.

Eligibility

- Must be currently be enrolled in the Manufacturing Pathway at the Career Pathways Institute.
- Must be pursuing a degree, certificate, or diploma in Manufacturing Technology or Machining
- Must meet requirements of acceptance to the trade program at an accredited post-secondary school of choice

Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

Terms of Payment

The scholarships will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university. Payments will be made in equal installments for up to four semesters. The student must provide proof of enrollment to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.
