

PEO Chapter EZ Scholarship

P.E.O. is an international organization of women who are interested in philanthropy and higher education. The local EZ Chapter has been offering scholarships to young women in Hall County since 1985. The scholarship is a one year, \$500 award, payable to the college or university of the student's choice.

Scholarship Eligibility

- Must be female
- Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior High, Grand Island Central Catholic, Grand Island Northwest, Heartland Lutheran, Doniphan-Trumbull, Wood River, or Centura
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Preference will be given to students who demonstrate financial need
- Must be involved in at least three school activities and at least two community activities
