Eligibility

- Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior High, Grand Island Northwest, Grand Island Central Catholic or Heartland Lutheran High School
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Must demonstrate financial need by qualifying for the Free/Reduced Lunch Program
- Must be from a single parent family
