

Wasmer PTA Scholarship

Wasmer Elementary School, named after Grand Island businessman Charles Wasmer who donated the land for the original school, has a strong academic tradition and belief in life-long learning. The Wasmer Parent Teacher Association desires to continue that tradition into post-secondary education for Wasmer graduates seeking to go on to a college, university, community college, technical school or trade school. The Wasmer PTA will provide two \$300 scholarships each year for qualifying Grand Island graduates who attended Wasmer during their elementary years.

Eligibility

- Must be a graduating senior from Grand Island Senior High, Northwest High School, Grand Island Central Catholic, or Heartland Lutheran
- Must have attended Wasmer Elementary School for at least three years
- Must rank in the top 33% of the class
- Must have applied to a school or institution of higher learning

Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation that will include representatives from the Wasmer PTA.

Terms of Payment

The scholarships will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to an accredited college or university. The student must provide proof of enrollment to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.
