Are you graduating from high school in December 2018 or Spring 2019?

Will you receive your high school diploma from Grand Island Senior High, Ombudsman, or Success Academy?

Enter reference information, make sure to ask first!

If you qualify for the free or reduced school lunch program, upload your benefit letter.

If you do not have a copy of the benefit letter and attend GISH, you can email Kari Price at kprice@gips.org and request a pdf copy.

Write additional specific essays if you qualify. Read guidelines to see which scholarships you qualify for.

Proof essays in the application for character errors. (character errors can happen when text is copied into the application)
