8610 STUDENT LEADERSHIP COUNCILS

The Grand Island Public Schools encourages student participation in the various activities of school life and to provide opportunity for training in democratic processes. The schools of the district may maintain and operate student councils and such councils shall assist in improving the general welfare of all students and shall give students the opportunity to participate in the orderly workings of the democratic process.

Student councils shall not have authority to make policies for the district or regulations for the school; nor shall they have any disciplinary authority, except for recommending removal from the council of one of their members. However, a council may make recommendations to the administration on topics of student interests or concerns.

The administration and student council of any school shall keep channels of communication open between all students and the council.

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
