Lincoln Elementary School is located at 805 North Beal Street. The original school was built in 1911 to help the swelling enrollment at Howard Elementary. Continuous gains in the area's population caused necessary additions to be built in 1913, 1920, and 1931. Structural deterioration along with modern educational requirements initiated a bond campaign in 1996. The new two-unit Lincoln Elementary opened its doors in the fall of 1998 with an enrollment of 220. Steady growth continues. Lincoln is a schoolwide Title One school.
