At GIPS, we advocate for our students to "Dress for Success". Below are a few updated guidelines the district has provided for appearance expectations while at school.

Attire Guidelines:

- Freedom of expression with respect to updated apparel guidelines.
- Apparel must comply with the health and safety codes and not detract from learning.
- For all students, mid-thigh to top of chest are to be covered while also concealing all undergarments.
- District required masks, approved religious attire, or protective headwraps are approved; At this time due to safety hoods, caps, bandanas, durags, etc. are not approved.
- Apparel that is advertising or advocating for controlled or illegal substances, or promoting a hostile environment will not be permitted.
- For grades 6-12, school issued ID shall be made visible on the upper torso.
