Developmental Milestones

0-1 Years Old

- Smiles when spoken to or smiled at, by 2 months
- · Holds head up by 4 months
- Reaches to grab a toy by 6 months
- · Makes different sounds like "mamama" and "bababa" by 9 months
- · Walks, holding on to furniture by 12 months

1-2 Years Old

- Hugs stuffed doll or other toy by 15 months
- · Helps get dressed by pushing arm through sleeve by 18 months
- Walks without holding on to anyone or anything by 18 months
- Tries to say three or more words besides "mama" or "dada" by 18 months
- Points to at least two body parts when asked by 2 years
- Eats with a spoon by 2 years

3 Years Old

- · Balances on one foot briefly
- · Throws ball with direction
- Matches six colors
- · Counts to five
- Uses toilet independently
- · Washes and dries hands unassisted
- · Plays with other children
- Engages in dramatic and pretend play
- Responds to two-step directions
- Answers "What," and "When" questions

4 Years Old

- · Walks up and down stairs, alternating feet
- Cuts on line
- Points to and names three shapes
- Tells story by looking at pictures
- Plays and interacts with other children
- Responds verbally to "Hi," and "How Are You?"
- Talks about event using past and future tenses

5 Years Old

- Skips
- Cuts out simple shapes
- · Copies their own first name
- Counts by rote to ten
- Dresses oneself completely
- · Brushes teeth
- Plays simple board games
- · Engages in cooperative play with other children
- Uses complex sentences
